So, due to this situation the mostly affected are the people who do labour work or such kind of work for which the people get daily wages. But, due to no work, the people are not getting daily wages which is ultimately resulting in their daily need of food. As they are not able to earn money, they are not able to buy themselves the food. So, to work for these people who are needy, all the NSS units of SKNCOE, SCOE, SCOS and NBN in collaboration with Kartavya Welfare Trust have stepped forward for the needy people by donating the essentialfoodrationkits. Thus, in total 588 kits were distributed and the expenses for these kits was equal to INR 1,80,147/-.




The most successful moment for the camp was the donation of O- blood straight away from the blood donation camp to a new born baby in the case or emergency to the hospital, nearby Pune Station.



<u>Day-1</u> (5 January 2020):-





Day-2 (6 January 2020):-



As per the daily routine, after morning exercise and singing of the national anthem and NSS song, cleaning of the base camp i.e. the school premises was also done.




Day 6 (10 January 2020):-



The De-monetisation drive in India left a lot of unanswered questions after it was put in effect. Though it was a strong policy to counter fake currency and terrorism the common public was not prepared for it though there were mechanisms in place to supplement to solving the cash crunch crisis.

We as a NSS unit in these pressing times decided to help the situation by conducting a cashless transaction awareness drive in our college campus shops and those near our campus. We decided to target shops, hotels and cafes as these are the places from where cash flows through the economy at the grass root level and educating and helping these members of the cash cycle will help propagate the knowledge about cashless rather easily.

We approached shops and hotels and taught them how to use different services related to cashless transactions like paid services provided by companies like PayTM, Freecharge and MobiKwik. We also , later , spread knowledge about governmental services like BHIM and RuPay.

Almost all of these services required an active internet connection so we also recommended the newly founded "*99#" service which runs completely on GSM networks and is thus more reliable and readily available.







N.S.S. DAY REPORT

24th September, 2016 was observed as N.S.S. Day by the N.S.S. Unit of SKNCOE. Cleanliness drive was conducted in the Sinhgad college campus and a visit to a school of 'Special Kids' (Nivasi Matimand Vidyalay) was organized as a part of N.S.S. Day celebration.



All the N.S.S. members assembled at the Cultural Center of the college at 11 am in the morning. Placards with various cleanliness quotes were made by the group members. General instructions were given to the members after assembling. The members were made to stand in rows and the rally began by singing the national anthem. The planned path of the rally was a loop path from C.C to C.C (Culcural Center-Amul-Pharmacy College-Lipton-SIOM-NRI Hostel Area-Science College-NBN-SKN parking-Cultural Center).


