

#### Memorandum of Understanding

by and between

**Study Estonia, India** having its registered office at Pune. India subsidiary of Red Mango Coaching Company (Hereinafter referred to as "Study Estonia")

#### and

Sinhgad Institutes, having its registered office at 19/15, Smt. Khilare Marg, Erandwane, Pune, 411040. (Hereinafter referred to as "Sinhgad Institutes")

Study Estonia, India and Sinhgad Institutes agree to cooperate with each other as follows for an international cooperation. Subject to mutual consent, the areas of cooperation will include any program offered by either Study Estonia (Red Mango Coaching company) or Sinhgad Institutes as thought desirable and feasible on either side and that both sides will contribute to the fostering and development of the cooperative relationship between the two. Cooperation shall be carried out through such activities as:

- Student Admission Conclave, for admission to Estonian Universities at Sinhgad Institutes
  - Exchange of faculty and/or staff between Estonian Universities and Sinhgad Institutes
- Customization of short term summer and winter schools for students of Sinhgad Institutes
- 4. PhD Programs for faculty members of Sinhgad Institutes

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this MoU shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both Study Estonia and Sinhgad Institutes prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such MoUs entered into, as outlined above, will form appendices to this MoU for Cooperation. Both Red Mango



Coaching Company and Sinhgad Institutes hereby agree on the following articles to establishthe International Cooperation.

# Student Admission Conclave at Sinhgad Institutes

The aim of student admission conclave is to offer on the spotevaluations to the students of Sinhgad Institutes, which shall expedite the application process for admissions. The representatives from Estonian university shall evaluatestudents based on individual university requirements. The generic process entails Skype interviews with the professors of courses applied, motivational letter submission. previous academic marksheets, English language test IELTS/TOEFL for example. The decision of admission/evaluation shall completely be discretion of the university personnel.

#### 2. Exchange of faculty and/or staff

Faculty exchange may assume various forms, such as individualshort-time and long term visits of faculties, joint research anddevelopment projects. Encouragement of the academic faculty to co-author publications, joint research activities and joint project possibilities is in subject toapplicable copyright and / or other laws of each country, as well asrules and regulations of the perspective universities (per se Estonian Universities and Sinhgad Institutes). As applicable. Estonian universities and Sinhgad Institutes shall arrange foraccommodation and food during the exchange program period.

#### 3. Customization of short term summer and winter schools

Customization of short term summer and winter schools for students of Sinhgad Institutes. Student groups over 20 in number can have special programscustomized by the Estonian universities. Summer/Winter school programs are between two to four weeks ofduration. Costs of the program, travel to Estonia, accommodation and food shall be borne by the students.

4. PhD Programs for faculty members of Sinhgad Institutes

Specific requirements, for admission to PhD program, depend on the requirements of theinstitution of higher education at the Estonian universities and the particular course. Specific requirements manufacture an entrance examination, thesis plan or

aninterview etc. Doctoral studies in Estonia are without tuition fee and with variousgrants and scholarship opportunities. Funding of travel, accommodation and living cost is soleresponsibility of the faculty or Sinhgad Institutes. Study Estonia or theuniversity shall not be responsible for the funds.

### Entry into Effect and Termination

- This MoU will come into effect on the date of signature and will be valid for a period of <u>C2</u> years, thereafter.
- Expiry of the MoU shall occur when either side notifies the other side, in writing, of its intention to terminate this MoU with least three (3) months notice.
