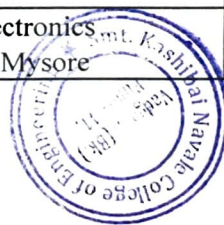



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This memorandum of understanding (MoU) is made on 01/08/2016 at Pune between Gofigito Educorp LLP, located at C-27, Swapnashilpa Society, Gulwani Mahanaj Road, Pune, 411038 hereafter referred to as *Gofigito*.

And

Sinhgad Technical Education Society situated at 19/15, Erandwane, Smt. Khilare Marg, off Karve Road, Pune, India, 411041 hereafter referred to as *STES*.

The purpose of this MoU is to facilitate the provision of a 30 hour training program on following modules:

- Module 1: Quantitative Aptitude and Logical Reasoning – 20 hours
- Module 2: Group Discussion and Interview Preparation – 10 hours

Validity: This MoU is valid for a period of 3 years from the date of signing. Either party can terminate this agreement during the period of the agreement by issuing a written notice of 3 months.

Deliverables: Gofigito will facilitate the delivery of the training modules, Module 1 and Module 2, in following manner.

Terms & Conditions


The STES will provide the necessary infrastructure, class room with LCD facility, as well as round level support for the conduction of the training program.

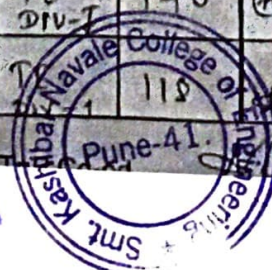

- Planning and handling of courses to promote cross cultural education.
- Organization of seminars/ workshops to gain practical and international exposure by sharing experiences, and teaching.

- *Establishing strong business relationships between both parties.*

- *Students Internships Terms:*

- The Internship programme details are made available to the graduate students. Interested students can apply for projects / Courses of their choice and can prepare well for a rigorous selection procedure.
- Selected student for internship program will be subject to the admission requirements, tuition fees & accommodation fees of the CMI, Aalborg University.
- The student internship program will run with the minimum of 20 students and the maximum of 30 students per duration. Any variation in the number of students needs to be agreed by both the parties.



- The period of Internship in Nov/Dec will be around 3 weeks and for summer intake it can possibly be 4 weeks.
 - The CMI should provide training/technical guidance to the students. CMI will organize the activities as a domain specific course of 5 ECTS. Groups of students will study recent issue/problems under CMI appointed supervisor.
 - Internship completion certificate will be issued to the students by the CMI, Aalborg University.
- *Financial Terms:*
 - This MoU imposes financial obligations allied with knowledge transfer, conduction of sessions for students, accommodation, food and travels.
 - For each intern, financial requirements were agreed for a period of 3 to 4 weeks and these are:
 - Internship Fee (Session, Course, etc): 6500 DKK
 - STES will be financially responsible for Accommodation, Food, Travels including local transportation and CMI will assist with local arrangements.
 - STES will be a common window to deal with financial obligations.

The CMI will evaluate the students and determine their acceptability for admission as intern student. The CMI reserves the right to reject the home university's nominated students. The home university may appeal the rejection.




